Photography:- In view of the provisions of the G.N.A.S. Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy. Those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Unauthorized photographs or filming will not be permitted. Teams:- Team Recurve:-

A team of four archers, may be all adults, male or female, may include a junior but not more than one. All archers to be from the same club. The same club meaning the club that the archer affiliates through, or their primary club.

Team Compound:-

A team of three archers, may be all adults, male or female, may include a junior but not more than one. All archers to be from the same club. The same club meaning the club that the archer affiliates through, or their primary club.

Nominated Mixed Pairs – Recurve

Team of two, one male and one female, of the same bow type. Pair to be nominated before the first sighter arrow. Both archers to be from the same club. The same club meaning the club that the archer affiliates through, or their primary club.

Nominated Mixed Pairs – Compound

Team of two, one male and one female, of the same bow type. Pair to be nominated before the first sighter arrow. Both archers to be from the same club. The same club meaning the club that the archer affiliates through, or their primary club.

Best Gold:- Adult Male and Female irrespective of bow type. (not including sighters).

Junior Male and Female irrespective of bow type. (not including sighters).

Longbow/Barebow Male or Female, taken over the first 6 doz. (not including sighters).

Colour Prizes:- No distinction for gender, or bow type.

Faces:- All archers will shoot on a 120cm face at all distances.

G.N.A.S. Membership:- This shoot is being staged in accordance with the G.N.A.S. (Archery GB) Rules of Shooting. As such ALL archers entering will be required to show a Valid Membership Card with registration number. Those archers unable to produce this documentation at registration on the day of the shoot, may not be allowed to shoot. No refunds will be considered in this event.

Jnr Ladies Under 18	60 Yards
Jnr Ladies Under 16	50 Yards
Jnr Ladies Under 13	40 Yards

For a Junior ladies there is a Bristol V round that is recognised by G.N.A.S. However, it is not possible to gain a classification in this round, nor is it recognised in a Record Status shoot. The distances are 20 yards, 15 yards and 10 yards. These

Jnr Gentlemen Under 18	80 Yards
Jnr Gentlemen Under 16	60 Yards
Jnr Gentlemen Under 14	50 Yards
Jnr Gentlemen Under 12	40 Yards
